In cooperation with UNESCO and the World Bank (through the GIQAC project), the International Network for Quality Assurance Agencies in Higher Education (INQAAHE) is providing funds for QA representatives from developing countries to attend the 11<sup>th</sup> Biennial INQAAHE forum.

The 11th biennial forum is hosted by the Namibian Qualifications Authority (NQA) and will be held in Windhoek, Namibia on Wednesday 5 and Thursday 6 May, 2010. The forum theme will be "The responsiveness of External Quality Assurance Agencies" On Tuesday, May 4<sup>th</sup>, two pre-forum workshops will be organised.

INQAAHE and GIQAC offer scholarships (of up to USD \$2500 each) to participants to cover some of the traveling, accommodation and registration costs. The funds will be limited and preference will be given to representatives of African QA agencies, especially to staff of quality assurance agencies in a founding stage and members of INQAAHE who have not received funding for attending the conference of 2009 or forum of 2008.

Members wishing to apply for some financial support, should complete the attached application form, giving a clear motivation, and indicating how their attendance could contribute to the work of their agency. Also an estimate of the total costs, broken down by travel, accommodation and registration should be provided. The applicant should give an indication of how much of the costs they will pay themselves and hence the amount of financial support they would like to receive from INQAAHE.
