

# Sustainability: INQAAHE Operations



#### **Board**

Staggered approach:

- August 2020: first steps to operationalize the approach
- Election of 3 members and cooption of 3
- August 2021:
  - Next round of elections
  - Election of President by the Board subject to approval by the GA

Broad involvement of members in the Board activities through

- Identifying and inviting individuals with appropriate potential to take a stronger leadership role in matters related to the Network.
- A strong emphasis in mentoring new Board members.

#### Secretariat

In-depth study on the potential feasible models and venues for establishment of a permanent International Headquarter

Call for proposals to the members:

- 4 proposals were submitted

#### Final decision:

- Barcelona, Spain
- With the support from AQU
   Catalonia during the first transition years

#### Staff:

- GGP Procedure coordinators
- Administrative support (e.g. hiring new staff and internships)

### **Chief Executive Officer**

Establishment of a CEO position on a pilot basis for 2 years

#### Key expectations:

- Diversification of funding
- Sustainability
- Enhanced visibility and impact



## **INQAAHE Support to Members**

Strengthening External Quality Assurance of Kyrgyzstan October 2020 – July 2021

Under the auspices of UNESCO and as per the request from the Kyrgyz Ministry of Education and Science INQAAHE bided and was selected to conduct the baseline analysis and facilitate a national consultation to strengthen quality assurance systems in Kyrgyzstan.

Financial support has been provided from the Republic of Korea Funds-in-Trust (2020-2023) and INQAAHE.

#### INQAAHE's role is to:

- Conduct an independent assessment of the quality assurance system, policies and standards against relevant international guidelines in Kyrgyzstan;
- Co-organize a national consultation on quality assurance systems for higher education;
- Provide actionable recommendations on implementing quality standards to promote international alignment of quality assurance agencies in Kyrgyzstan.


