



Definitions

Micro-credential (EC, 2020):

"A micro-credential is a proof of the learning outcomes that a learner has acquired following a short learning experience. These learning outcomes have been assessed against transparent standards".



"A group of courses (units, modules or other learning building blocks) with a common subject focusing on specific needs in society and which are part of larger degrees".





Challenges

- Coordination between different stakeholders (public employment system, HE system, HEI, AQU Catalunya).
- Level 6 and 7 of EQF / level 4 and 5 of National catalogue of professional qualifications (CNCP).
- Be part of the occupational training programmes subsidised by public employment system.
- Recognition (ECTS) by HEI in Catalunya.
- Quality assurance.



- Response to the needs of the labour market (strong applied / occupational character).
- Level 6 and 7 of EQF / level 4 and 5 of CNCP.
- 5 60 ECTS.
- ECTS recognition in official degrees.
- Provider: HEI.
- Target audience: "non-traditional" students (re-skilling / upskilling; employed / unemployed).
- Quality assurance: ex-ante evaluation.



Assessment dimensions - Pilot

- **1. Description of SLP:** university, name of SLP, EQF level, relationship with the professional family, ECTS, mode of delivery, offer
- **2. Rationale:** relevance of the program to labour market, and potential of the institution to deliver the programme
- 3. Aims and learning outcomes
- 4. Student access and admission
- **5. Planning of SLP:** structure of the curriculum, coherence between intended learning outcomes, mode of delivery, and teaching and assessment activities.
- **6.** Teaching and support staff
- 7. Material resources and services
- **8. Expected results:** academic results, student satisfaction, employability

Procedure. Steps

SLP design

- Institutional WG (driving institutions and specialised organisation of SLP field).
- Academic WG (experts from different HEI).

HEI

- Capacity of HEI to implement SLP.

Validation

- AQU Catalunya
- Spanish public employment service

- 33 HEI are going to offer SLP.
- Between 8 15 ECTS.
- Level 6 EQF, except data scientist (level 7).
- Mode of delivery: face to face, blended, on line.

Conclusions



- Coordination between different stakeholders (policy makers, labour maket, HEI, AQU).
- Gateway between HE and professional system.
- Strengthen connections and establish a common language among the actors involved.
- External assessment ensures recognition of SLPs and improve trust.
- Workload associated to external review and the short period of time life of SLP, it seems reasonable to look for another strategy more focused on the IQAS.










The future....
