

What and Who are Edtech Providers


- Digital technology in education that includes hardware and software solutions


- Capital inflows are higher than ever

Why is this a concern for QAA?

- Edtech providers may:
 - Have intimate and intricate involvement in institutional and departmental affairs
 - May operate substantial share of institutions' online programs
 - Enroll large portions of student population
 - Operate too much of the academic activity that should be the purview of the institution
 - Lock institutions into long-term onerous contracts



The Opportunities

- 3. What level of engagement have you had with these providers?



The Challenges

Challenges to Discuss

- 1. Absence of (appropriate) standards for that group or type of HE provider
- 2. QAA Capacity expertise and qualifications to review/evaluate agreements
- 3. QAA Confusion on Jurisdiction
- 4. Vague understanding/knowledge of arrangements with HEIs (including academic)
- Lack of access to ED-Tech processes (transparency)
- 6. External influences political, economical, social that may be beyond the control of the QAA
